PUBLIC HEARING Mayor Kidd opened a public hearing May 8, 2018 at 7:00 pm as advertised for the purpose of hearing comments on a proposal to dispose of and sell city-owned property at 1402 Walnut Street (Police Building). He asked for written comments, there were none. He asked for oral comments. Mayor Kidd declared the hearing closed at 7:01 pm.

The Dallas Center City Council met in regular session May 8, 2018 at 7: 02 pm. Mayor Kidd called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance. Council members present included David Bagby, Danny Beyer, Ryan Coon, Ryan Kluss and Curtis Pion.

The agenda was amended to remove item #9 resident of 1603 Laurel Street request to vacate Raccoon River Valley Trail right-of-way. Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Beyer to approve the amended agenda. Motion passed 5-0.

Motion by Pion, 2nd by Coon to approve consent agenda [approve minutes of April 10 regular meeting and April 17 and April 26 special meetings; April Treasurer's Report; April Fire/Rescue, Law Enforcement, Compliance and Water Reports; accept Chuck Comito's resignation from Plan and Zoning; approve changing April Scrivner's employment to full time status effective June 18, 2018 (first payroll in July); approve Mayor's reappointment of Robert Findlay to the Library Board (term expires June 30, 2021); approve Mayor's reappointment of Sue Beavers to the Library Board (term expires June 30, 2021); approve sidewalk reimbursement for 301 10th Street - \$128.00; approve sidewalk reimbursement for 1205 Ash Street - \$180.00; approve hiring; 1st year lifeguards at \$8.00/hr – Ashley Perkins, Alysa Rath, Jillian Rants, Zoey Ross; all hires pending lifeguard certification and background checks with start date of May 9, 2018; approve street closing request for the American Legion's Memorial Day Observance; approve Fall Festival street closing request; approve Twisted Corn outdoor liquor license and beer garden pending dram shop; approve Twisted Corn street closing request for BACoon Ride; approve invoices for payment (review committee Pion and Bagby)]. Motion passed 5-0.

Hearing appeal of Brenton Brothers Inc. on nuisance abatement notice on property in 500 block of Kellogg. Motion by Beyer, 2nd by Pion to approve the Findings of Fact whereby Brenton Brothers has agreed to abate the nuisance by removing the designated items by 5:00 pm on June 30, 2018 and to comply with the Property Maintenance Code of Dallas Center by removing the white barn and the partial-brick hog building by 5:00 pm on December 31, 2018. Motion passed 5-0.

Martin Gross with Gross-Wen Technologies presented information on their system to the council.

Motion by Pion, 2nd by Kluss to approve submission of Wellmark Grant application for up to \$25,000 to 1. Finish the tennis court, 2. Finish roofs on the dug-outs, 3. Trail/school connector. Motion passed 5-0.

Motion by Pion, 2nd by Beyer authorizing a donation to Valley Disaster Tree Service for services rendered at the Burnett Complex and Mound Park in the amount of \$250.00. Motion passed 5-0.

Mike Buckalew-discussed vandalism in parks and the potential for a Crimestoppers fund. Council discussed having the Public Safety Committee research this topic and to have the Parks and Recreation Board discuss with ISU (who is working on a park study) to consider vandalism issues in their study.

Motion by Pion, 2nd by Coon to approve Resolution 2018-20 – disposing of and selling property at 1402 Walnut Street now belonging to the City of Dallas Center. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

Dusty Rauschenberg discussed the purpose of the Public Service Recognition Week Proclamation and thanked all public servants for their service. Motion by Coon, 2nd by Bagby to approve Public Service Recognition Week Proclamation. Motion passed 5-0.

Slaughter gave the public works report.

Veenstra gave a project update on the Southwest Stormwater Drainage Improvements Project – contractor is still working on clean-up, grading issues and bio-swale installation.

Veenstra had no update on the Water Treatment Plant Project.

Veenstra had no update on the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Motion by Beyer, 2nd by Pion to approve Resolution 2018-21 – approving Capital Improvement Program. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

Motion by Beyer, 2nd by Kluss directing Veenstra & Kimm to prepare an amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan to include as a project the construction of a sewer main along Fair View Drive north to Highway 44. Motion passed 5-0

Veenstra will convey to Spurgeon Manor the options of access to Linden Street from their proposed new facility.

Motion by Pion, 2nd by Kluss to authorize Clerk to pay Economic Development Grant of \$15,454.43 (from TIF funds) on June 1 to Pioneer Hi-Bred International, Inc. pursuant to Agreement for Private Development dated October 11, 2011 (4th of 5 payments). Motion passed 5-0.

Council took no action on Happe Homes request to waive penalties assessed on March 16 in the amount of \$12.45 and April 16 in the amount of \$1.25.

Council reports-Council discussed updating the City's website, Coon stated she is willing to assist. Council discussed software/computer updates, clerk has received quotes for next fiscal year.

ORDINANCE NO. 521

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 165 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DALLAS CENTER, IOWA, AS AMENDED, (THE ZONING CODE) BY ADDING PROVISIONS ALLOWING BEEKEEPING IN CERTAIN DISTRICTS UNDER CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Dallas Center, Iowa, that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 165 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Dallas Center, Iowa, as amended, is hereby amended by adding the following new section:

- 165.30A SPECIFIC USE REGULATIONS BEEKEEPING. Beekeeping is allowed, without any regulation or restriction, in the A-1 (Existing Agricultural) District and the A-2 (Agricultural/Residential) District. Beekeeping also is allowed in the R-1 (Single-Family Residential) District, the R-2 (Low Density Multi-Family Residential) District, the E-1 (Single-Family Rural Estate) District, and the C-2 (Highway/Auto-Oriented Business) District, subject, however, to the following regulations and restrictions:
 - 1. Beekeeping shall only be allowed on property owned by the beekeeper or by a third party for which the beekeeper has written authorization from the property owner allowing for the keeping of bees.
 - 2. Honeybee colonies shall be kept in hives with removable frames, with the hives kept in sound and usable condition.
 - 3. A maximum of three (3) hives shall be permitted on a property one acre or smaller in size, while a maximum of ten (10) hives shall be permitted on a property larger than one acre in size.
 - 4. Hives shall not be located in the front or side yard.
 - 5. A source of water shall be readily available to the bees within the property that the beehives are located at

- all times during the time of year in which the bees are active.
- 6. When a hive is situated within twenty-five feet of a property line, as measured from the nearest point on the hive to the property line, the beekeeper shall establish and maintain a flyway barrier parallel to the property line(s) which is a minimum of six feet in height consisting of a solid wall of a building, fence, dense vegetation or combination thereof. The flyway barrier shall extend a minimum of twelve feet beyond the hive in all directions so that all bees are forced to fly at an elevation of at least six feet above ground level over the property line(s) of the apiary. Dense vegetation used as a flyway barrier may exceed a height of six feet; however, the vegetation shall be a minimum of six feet in height at the time the beehives are located on the property. A building permit shall be obtained prior to the construction of any building or fence.
- 7. As recommended by the Iowa State Apiarist, the beekeeper shall incorporate best management practices in the beekeeping operation at all times, including practicing property management and manipulation of colonies to remedy swarming and/or aggressive colonies.
- 8. Before beginning beekeeping activities, the beekeeper shall complete a beekeeping course, class, or school sponsored by the Iowa Honey Producers Association, a governmental entity, or similar organization. Before beginning beekeeping activities, the beekeeper shall register, without charge, the beekeeping activities with the City Clerk on a form which will provide the beekeeper's name, contact information, and location of the hives, as well as certifying the completion of the beekeeping course, class, or school.
- 9. Beekeepers are encouraged to register the location of their beehives with the Iowa State Apiarist.
- 10. The City is not liable for any damage to bees, hives, colonies, or beekeeping operations resulting from the City's use of spray to kill pests or weeds on public rights of way or public property.
- 11. The beekeeper shall indemnify and hold harmless the City from and against all damages, claims, actions, suits,

and demands arising from the beekeeper's beekeeping operation.

- 12. In the event a beekeeping operation is determined to be in violation of this Chapter, the beekeeper and/or property owners shall be given written notice of the violation and be allowed fourteen days from the date of the notice to correct the violation. If the property is not brought into compliance within the fourteen day period, the hives shall be immediately removed from the property.
- **SECTION 2.** Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part there of not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
- **SECTION 4.** When Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

CITY OF DALLAS CENTER, IOWA SOUTHWEST STORMWATER DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE 1 ADDITONAL RETRAINAGE RELEASE

This City of Dallas Center partially released the retainage held on the Southwest Stormwater Drainage Improvements – Phase 1 project. The City reduced the retainage being held to \$40,000, or twice the \$20,000 estimated cost for Progressive Structures, LLC to complete the remaining work on the project.

As indicated in the writer's previous correspondence, the contractor can request further reductions in the retainage as work is completed. At such time as all of the work in completed and there is no longer a need to hold retainage, the property procedure is to formally accept the project.

Recently, Progressive Structures, LLC requested all of the remaining \$40,000 in retainage be released. Progressive Structures, LLC appears to dispute the substantive items remaining on the punch list. In addition to these items there are a number of erosion control issues and seeding issues. In several issues a stand of grass has not been fully established. The erosion control devices must remain until the area is stabilized and these devices can be removed. There are areas that were just seeded and it is unknown whether a full stand of grass will be established.

Based on the work remaining to be completed, the project is not to a point where all the retainage should be paid after acceptance of the project. That being said, Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. agrees Progressive Structures, LLC has completed many of the items on the punch list and a further reduction in the retainage would be appropriate.

Based on the work remaining to be completed as of May 25, 2018, Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. estimates the value of the work to be completed would be in the range of \$7,500. This value of work remaining to be completed would provide for a reduced retainage in the amount of \$15,000. Based on the status of the work remaining to be completed it would appear the City should release an additional \$25,000 of the retainage. The approval of the retainage release would be at the June 12, 2018 City Council meeting.

It is Veenstra & Kimm, Inc.'s plan to process a partial payment estimate with the additional release of retainage. As of this date an additional \$25,000 of retainage would be paid. The partial payment estimate will not be prepared until June 5, 2018. If Progressive Structures, LLC completes additional work by that date that reduces the value of the work remaining to be completed the retainage release amount may be increased above \$25,000.

Enclosed is a copy of Partial Payment Estimate No. 15 for the Southwest Stormwater Drainage Improvements - Phase 1 project. Partial Payment Estimate No. 15 is in the amount of \$25,000.

Progressive Structures, LLC requested an early retainage release on the project. In Partial Payment Estimate No. 14 the City reduced the retainage to \$40,000, or twice the value of the work remaining to be completed.

Since early May, Progressive Structures, LLC has completed additional work on the project. There are still a number of punch list or cleanup items remaining to be completed. At the end of May 2018, Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. evaluated the amount of work remaining to be completed. The evaluation indicated the estimated value of the work remaining to be completed is \$7,500. Under the early retainage release requirements the City can reduce the retainage to twice the value of the work remaining to be completed or \$15,000.

Partial Payment Estimate No. 15 reduces the retainage from \$40,000 to \$15,000 and provides payment in the amount of \$25,000.

Progressive Structures, LLC has asserted the value of the work remaining to be completed is less than \$7,500. There has been an indication Progressive Structures, LLC might post a bond for the remaining retainage items. As of June 6, 2018 no retainage release bond has been provided.

The enclosed estimate has not been signed by Progressive Structures, LLC. It is uncertain whether Progressive Structures, LLC is in agreement with the payment or is still asserting there should be a larger payment.

Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. indicated to Progressive Structures, LLC the options are to proceed with Partial Payment Estimate No. 15 or to defer any additional retainage release until July 2018 as there is not time to evaluate and a further reduction in the retainage release prior to the agenda deadline for the June 12, 2018 City Council meeting.

Not receiving a response from Progressive Structures, LLC, the enclosed payment estimate is being transmitted with a recommendation for approval with a payment in the amount of \$25,000.
