The Dallas Center City Council met in regular electronic meeting via Zoom on June 18, 2020 at 6:00 pm due to lowa Governor Kim Reynold's May 26, 2020, updated Proclamation of Disaster Emergency, which among other matters, encouraged all vulnerable lowans to limit their activities outside of their home including their participation in gatherings of any size and any purpose. Effective June 1st, the Governor' Proclamation allows a community gathering (such as a public meeting) of more than ten persons so long as the venue capacity is limited and social distancing of at least six feet is maintained. The Governor further suspended state laws requiring a public meeting or hearing to the extent the laws could be interpreted to prevent a governmental body from limiting the number of people present for an in-person location of the meeting, providing the governmental body provides a means for the public to participate by telephone or electronically. Mayor Kidd called the meeting to order. Council members on the call/Zoom meeting were Curtis Pion, Danny Beyer, Amy Strutt and Ryan Kluss. Ryan Coon was not present. Also on the call/Zoom meeting were Tree Board members Gary Park and Greg Cagle.

Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Pion to approve the agenda. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

Council and Tree Board reviewed the Professional Services Proposals submitted by ISG, Inc. and Jeffrey L. Bruce & Company to prepare a master plan to implement streetscaping designs at the intersections of 13th, 14th, and 15th Streets and develop a Walnut Street Green Corridor.

Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Pion to award contract for Professional Services to ISG, Inc. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 6:20 pm.
