Reminder: it is **not allowed to connect** a **sump pump**, roof downspout, exterior foundation drain, areaway drain, or other source of surface run-off or groundwater to a building sewer or drain which in turn is connected directly or indirectly to a public sanitary sewer.

Open Burning is allowed from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM until May 10th. Burn only when the wind is calm and please do not burn wet debris that causes excess smoke. You may burn only yard waste, no household trash. **NO burning on the city streets** and never leave a fire unattended.

Yard waste pick-up will resume on April 6th. Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, twigs, etc.) can be placed on the curb for pick-up every Monday through November. To insure pick-up, yard waste should be:

- Out on your curb by 7:00 AM
- Placed in brown paper bags, paper grocery bags, cardboard boxes or trash cans
- Bundled brush tied securely with twine or string; weighing less than 50 lbs & no longer than 4' in length.

Code Enforcement News~

- Spring is here? Well we hope so! I thought this would be a good time for some reminders on what the city's code of ordinances say about junk, trash, litter and debris. This ordinance not only keeps the community safe but does make the quality of life in Dallas Center better. Unsightly properties can bring values down not only on themselves but other properties in the neighborhood as well. Furniture, appliances, limbs, wood and brush piles, auto parts, tires and many other items can be dangerous for children and provide harborage for pests and vermin. A good basic rule of thumb to use is: If it is not manufactured to be used outside it shouldn't be left/stored outside. If it is not in original condition it should not be stored outside. This would include "used" lumber and anything that would hold water. It takes less than a cup of water for mosquito larva to grow.
- 51.02 JUNK, JUNK VEHICLES AND REFUSE PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for any
 person to store, accumulate, or allow to remain on any private property within the
 corporate limits of the City any junk, junk vehicle or refuse.
- 51.01 DEFINITIONS. For use in this chapter, the following terms are defined: "Junk" means all odd or scrap copper, brass, lead, or any other non-ferrous metal; old or discarded rope, rags, batteries, paper trash, rubber debris, waste or used lumber, or salvaged wood; broken, discarded or worthless things; old, dilapidated, obsolete inoperable or dismantled vehicles, tractors, machinery and appliances or parts of such vehicles, tractors, machinery or appliances; iron, steel or other old or scrap ferrous materials; old or discarded glass, tinware, plastic; old or discarded household goods or hardware, used building materials, tanks, cans, barrels, boxes, drums, piping, bottles, hair, mattresses, beds or bedding; or any other kind of scrap or waste material which is stored, kept, handled or displayed for barter, resale, reuse, salvage, stripping, or trade. Neatly stacked firewood located on a side yard or a rear yard is not considered junk.
