Therefore, this update does not include any new information, since the deadline for submission to the city newsletter is the 15th of the month! However, be assured that we are moving forward with our study of all the potential sites brought forward.</li> <li>We are in the process of refining the criteria a site must meet, as well as ranking that criteria in the order of importance. As we investigate the suitability of each site, we will weigh each against the criteria we have developed. This will give us a consistent means of evaluating each site.</li> <li>We are also in the process of investigating details about each site such as size suitability, access to foot and auto traffic/and parking, access to water and sewer hookups, access to telephone and wifi, soil stability/suitability, etc. Each site must be vetted in these and other ways.
