#### Utility news~

What's new in utilities? Effective July 16<sup>th</sup> water rates increased from \$8.82 to \$9.26 per 1000 gallons (see Ordinance 92.02). This increase will appear on your bill dated August 31, 2018 and will be due September 15, 2018. The new **minimum** residential monthly utility bill will be \$73.95. The minimum bill is for 3000 gallons of water and sewer, garbage and storm discharge. So if your monthly consumption is 3000 gallons or less your bill will be \$73.95. If your monthly water consumption is over 3000 gallons your bill will be higher.

# **Payment Options**

- On-Line Payment Reminder for those of you that use your bank's online bill pay for paying your water bill, please allow 7-10 business days for the check to reach us through mail. So, if you pay online a couple of days before the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, but we don't receive it until after the 15<sup>th</sup>, you will be assessed a penalty.
- Automatic bill pay is available for your City bill. If you are interested, contact City Hall at 992-3725 or cityhall@dallascenter.com.

#### Garbage stickers

- If you have additional garbage or bulk rubbish (furniture, etc.), garbage stickers may be purchased at the Roy R. Estle Memorial Library as well as City Hall.
- ♦ The cost per sticker is \$1.50 (this does not cover appliances).

**Building Permits** are required for all exterior building projects, sheds, additions, egress windows, driveways, fences, etc., AND interior remodeling. Permits can be obtained at City Hall or the Dallas Center website.

#### Law Enforcement Reminders:

- If you have a police matter that is not an emergency, please call Dallas County Dispatch at 993-4567. They will dispatch a law enforcement officer.
- If you have an emergency, please call 911.
- Complaints should be called in to dispatch
- After-hours city emergencies (water main breaks) should be called in to dispatch
- Always lock vehicles and don't leave valuables in your vehicle
- Put toys, bikes, etc. away at night

Yard waste reminders: Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, twigs, etc.) can be placed on the curb for pick-up every Monday through November. To insure pick-up, yard waste should be:

- Out on your curb by 7:00 am (this is the same as garbage and recycling)
- Placed in brown paper bags, paper grocery bags, cardboard boxes or trash cans (not Waste Management container)
- Bundled brush tied securely with twine or string; weighing less than 50 lbs & no longer than 4' in length

Do you know where the water shut off valve is inside your house? If you don't, you should find it. Then, "exercise" the valve (turn it off and on). If it does not work, call your friendly neighborhood plumber and get it fixed. At some time you may be glad you did!

- Central Iowa Regional Housing Authority (CIRHA) is a Housing Authority that helps low income families with rental assistance in Boone, Dallas, Jasper, Madison, Marion and Story counties.
- Families pay 30% of their gross adjusted income for the rent and the Housing Authority pays the difference directly to the landlord on the first of each month.
