Utility Bill Facts:

- Utility bills are always mailed on the last business day of the month for compliance of chapter 92.04 of our Code of Ordinances.
- Utility payments are due on the 15th of each month. If the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday the payment must be made before 9:30 a.m. the first business day following.
- You can pay your bill with cash or check at City Hall, by putting it in the night drop after hours or by signing up for auto pay.
- Utility rates are as follows: Water - \$9.26 per 1000 gallons with a minimum of 3000 gallons Sewer - \$7.21 per 1000 gallons with a minimum of 3000 gallons Garbage - \$19.50 (garbage, recycling, vard waste) Storm Discharge - \$4.00 Water Excise Tax - 6% based on water consumption. (\$1.67/3000 gallons)
- A customer with all of our services and uses 3000 gallons of water or less will have a minimum bill of \$74.58.
- As always, if you have any questions concerning your bill please call City Hall.

When the results of our Feasibility Study determined that a new library would not be financially possible, we began to explore Plan B. We have consulted with Pelds Engineering to begin the process to re-configure and add on to our original building. We've met with the American Legion and Auxiliary, and obtained their approval to relocate the monument that currently resides behind our building, to allow for extra room and will keep you updated as we progress! We appreciate all the support we have received throughout this process and are excited to see the plans coming together to have more space and programs on-site!!

Community News~

- Dallas County Pop Up Produce Stand-will be located at the library the 2nd Wednesday of the month (January-March) from 4:00-6:00 pm. The purpose of the stand is to bring low-cost, high quality fresh fruits and vegetables to rural towns that don't have a grocery store. While the produce is low-cost, it is meant for everyone in the community!

Winter Reminders ~

- Snow Parking Ban It is unlawful to park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley or city-owned off-street parking area during any snow removal period. The ban shall continue from the beginning of the snowfall to 24 hours after the snowfall has ceased.
- **Sidewalks -** Snow and ice removal from sidewalks is the responsibility of the property owner. Residents are required by ordinance to clear sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of a storm. Please pile the snow on your yard, not in the street.
- Fire Hydrants The Fire Department requests property owners who have a hydrant on their parking area to clear the snow away for easier access in case of fire.

Pet Licenses are required <u>ANNUALLY</u> in January

- → Purpose for identification if pet is lost, to prevent pets from being destroyed as stray, and as a way of tracking vicious animals.
- → **Registration** every dog or cat shall be registered with the City prior to January 1st of each year.
- Application Requirements provide proof of current vaccination against rabies, state breed, sex, age, color and name of dog or cat, and address, telephone, and signature of owner.
- → Registration Fees license fee is \$5.00. If the animal is not spayed or neutered, the fee is \$20.00 each. A \$5.00 late fee will be imposed on each dog or cat not registered by February 1st of each year.
- Impoundment registered animals found at large are subject to a municipal infraction of \$100.00-1st offense, \$200.00-2nd offense, \$400.00-3rd offense, \$625.00-4th offense. Unregistered animals or registered animals found at large on more than three (3) occasions shall be seized and impounded. Impounding costs are \$200.00.
- → Tags will not be mailed unless a pre-stamped envelope is included with the application.
