Public Works News~

Spring and Summer were a busy time for the Dallas Center Public Works Department! Along with the usual water and sewer plants daily monitoring and testing (yes this is a 7 day a week 365 days a year duty), the pool is added to this daily routine along with mosquito spraying once a week depending on the weather (optimal conditions for spraying are: no rain, wind speed no more than 10 mph and must begin at dusk) and maintenance of the pool, parks, streets, trees, trailhead and Burnett Complex along with the rest of the Cityowned grounds and buildings.

Some of the jobs and projects that were completed by Public Works this summer:

- Worked with MidAmerican Energy to solve electrical issues at the pool that have caused problems for the past few seasons.
- Replaced the damaged sidewalk at the trailhead.
- Tore out and disposed of the old tennis court in Mound Park so that a new one can be installed
- Started repairs on Percival Ave. north of Linden St.
- Monitored, responded to, and managed flood waters throughout the summer as well as cleaned up storm debris after.
- Oversaw asphalt overlay on Maple Street.
- Filled (and still filling) potholes. This is a never-ending job and we ask that if you are aware of a pothole that needs filled please call City Hall to report it.

This is a small sampling of what Public Works has accomplished the past few months.

Winter Reminders~

Streets-During snow events when plowing will be necessary, please remove all vehicles from City streets, alleys or City owned off-street parking areas. Vehicles parked in the street may be fined, towed or both. The parking ban will continue from the beginning of a snowfall to 24 hours after the snowfall has ceased. Sidewalks-you have 24 hours after the snowfall to clear your sidewalk or the City may do so and bill the property owner. Fire Hydrants-it is property owners' responsibility to clear the snow away from hydrants.
