Tree Board News~

- The Emerald Ash Borer has been confirmed in Dallas County. This means that all untreated ash trees in Dallas Center are expected to sicken and die over the next several years.
- If you have an ash tree in your yard that you would like to save, you should start treatment soon to maximize your tree's chance of survival. Prices are typically around \$15 per inch of trunk diameter.
- We recommend contacting a qualified tree care professional to do this work.

If you have extra garbage or large items (chairs, couches, mattresses, etc.) to dispose of, you can purchase **garbage stickers** at City Hall or the Roy R. Estle Memorial Library. The cost per sticker is \$1.50 (this does not cover appliances).
