Utility Information~

Water Service Excise Tax:

- The lowa legislature recently passed a new law which creates a Water Service Excise Tax (WET). WET exempts the sale of water service from state sales tax and Local Option Sales Tax (LOST), but imposes a 6% excise tax on the sale of water service. Beginning in July of this year, if you were previously subject to sales tax on your water consumption, you are now subject to WET tax instead.
- WET taxes collected will be distributed into two funds by the State the water quality infrastructure fund and the water quality assistance fund. These funds will provide money to the Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship and the lowa Finance Authority for improving water quality in lowa. Any remaining WET funds that are not distributed into either of these funds will be deposited into the State of lowa's General Fund. Visit lowa Department of Revenue's website tax.iowa.gov/WET for more information.

A Few Friendly Reminders:

- Utility payments are due on the 15th of each month. If the 15th falls on a weekend or holiday the payment must be made before 9:30 a.m. the **first** business day following.
- Payments made on or after the 20th of the month may not be reflected on your next hill
