Yard waste - Yard waste will be picked up every Monday through November. Yard waste can be placed in any container other than your Waste Management container. Bundle sticks and branches in no more than 4' lengths. Yard waste includes grass, leaves, twigs, etc.

If you have additional garbage or bulk rubbish (furniture, etc.), garbage stickers may be purchased at the Roy R. Estle Memorial Library as well as City Hall. The cost per sticker is \$1.50 (this does not cover appliances).

- The filing period is August 24 through September 17th at 5:00 PM.
- ° If you are thinking of running for an office, you are strongly encouraged to start attending the council meetings. This way you will be up to speed if you are elected to office.
