# Mayor's Message~

- Street Maintenance and Repairs Dallas Center receives Road Use Tax (or the fuel tax that was recently raised by the Iowa Congress) based on our population.
- Last year we received approximately \$201,000.
- We fund street projects (2017-15th Street by the middle school, 2016-Sycamore Street by the Co-op, 2015-700 block of 11th Street), street repairs (so far in 2017 public works has put 60 tons of cold patch on potholes with plans to do more) - the potholes never end! Road maintenance and repairs are prioritized by traffic volume, road condition and future plans.
- We also use these funds to help purchase equipment such as snow plows, skid loader, backhoe, street sweeper, etc., as well as to purchase the salt, sand and other supplies used during the snow removal and street repair processes.
- Some of this money also goes to help pay bonds for previous road projects (this helps keeps the debt levy lower).
- These funds will continue to be used to maintain, repair or replace our roads in the future.
