- Online payments can be made from our website at www.dallascenter.com through GovPayNet. Click on the "Online Payments" tab located on the home page. There is a 2.95% processing fee (with a minimum of \$1.00) added to your charge amount.
- Bank Bill Pay Reminder for those of you that use your bank's online bill pay for paying your water bill, please allow 7-10 business days for the check to reach us through the mail.
