PLEASE READ IF YOU ARE 65 OR OLDER

You may be eligible for a new homestead exemption. For your conveniences we have included the form. The form needs to be sent to the DALLAS COUNTY ACCESSORS OFFICE at 121 North 9th Street, Adel, Iowa 50003.

Here are some key points regarding this new exemption:

- 1. Applicants must be signed up by July 1, 2023
- 2. Applicants must be 65 by January 1, 2023.
- 3. The exemption will reduce the taxable value by \$3,250. This does not mean the credit will save the taxpayer \$3,250.
- 4. Even if you are already receiving the Homestead Credit, you have to reapply by July 1st to get this new exemption for 65 and over.
- 5. One exemption is allowed per household.

Code Enforcement Reminders

With summer quickly approaching, I wanted to give you some reminders to help keep Dallas Center a place we can all be proud of:

- Please pick up after your pets!
- Reminder that poultry, including chickens and ducks, are not allowed in town.
- Grass, weeds, or brush shall be cut, mowed and maintained so as not to exceed the following height specifications:
 - 1. Developed Residential Areas not to exceed eight inches (8").
 - 2. Undeveloped Residential Areas not to exceed ten inches (10")
 - 3. Business and Industrial Areas not to exceed eight inches (8"). Grass, weeds and brush which are allowed to grow in excess of the above specified limitations are deemed to be nuisances and to be violations.
- Tall grass, weeds, and brush/limb piles are not only unsightly, but they give cover for those bothersome and disease carrying mosquitoes.
- Anything that will hold water is an invitation for a mosquito. It only takes a hand full of water for a mosquito to lay eggs, so please don't leave open containers in the yard.
