### Public Notice of Storm Water Discharge:

The city of Dallas Center plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit Number 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities."

The storm water discharge will be from the installation of water main, final grading, and seeding. The site is located within Dallas Center city limits in sections 33 and 34 within the Sugar Grove Township of Dallas County, Iowa. The water main will be installed on the north side of Highway 44 in the public right of way, on city-owned and private property.

Storm water from the site will flow through Highway 44 ditches and into shared drainage lines, eventually reaching the Raccoon River.

Comments may be submitted to the Storm Water Discharge Coordinator, IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, Environmental Protection Division, Henry A Wallace Building, 502 E 9<sup>th</sup> St, Des Moines, IA 50319-0034. The public may review the Notice of Intent from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday-Friday at the above address after it has been received by the department.
