### **Municipal Water System Improvement**

- Removal and replacement of the current water filters began on October 26th
- The process of removing the old filters and installing the new filters will take approximately one to two months
- During this time, you may notice discolored water (rust or reddish in color)
- Please be assured the water will continue to be tested and will still be safe to drink, it may just be discolored
- We are asking residents to conserve water during this time
- Once the filter replacement is complete, the softening media will also be replaced

### Winter Reminders~

Streets-During snow events when plowing will be necessary, please remove all vehicles from City streets, alleys or City owned off-street parking areas. Vehicles parked in the street may be fined, towed or both. The parking ban will continue from the beginning of a snowfall to 24 hours after the snowfall has ceased. Sidewalks-you have 24 hours after the snowfall to clear your sidewalk or the City may do so and bill the property owner. Fire Hydrants-it is property owners' responsibility to clear the snow away from hydrants.

Please license you pets annually (before February 1st). Renewals for 2022 are now being accepted at City Hall. Please bring current rabies vaccination as we will not issue a license without this. If you want the tag mailed to you, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

#### Community News~

- The **Dallas Center Food Pantry** wants to send a BIG THANK YOU to the community for your on-going support through financial and food donations. Donations can be dropped off at Baker's Pantry in their donation basket, the Roy R. Estle Memorial Library vestibule, or at the food pantry during their open hours. All Dallas County residents in need of assistance can use the Food Pantry. There is no requirement for church affiliation or financial proof in order to utilize this service, they are glad to help those in need. The pantry has a large supply of canned goods, frozen and refrigerated items and it also provides personal hygiene products and paper products. It is open on Tuesday evenings from 4:00-6:00 pm at the Methodist Church, 1504 Walnut Street. There is an elevator if assistance is needed, please contact the food pantry at 515-487-6744 for information.
- SAILDC (Sustaining Active Independent Living in Dallas Center) is a nonprofit volunteer organization that, thanks to generous support from the DC Homebrewers Association and many Dallas Center citizens, will again offer snow removal services for those who can neither handle this task nor pay to have it done. Our volunteer drivers (all of whom have been vaccinated) continue to take residents to doctors and stores as needed. Will you need help with snow removal or trips to doctor's appointments? - Memorial/Commemorative trees in Dallas Center Parks. If you are interested in purchasing a memorial or commemorative tree to be placed in one of the Dallas Center city parks you first need to contact City Hall via email and your request will be sent to members of the Parks and Recreation Board. Board members will assist in designating a location for the tree and recommend species of tree. The purchase and planting of the tree are your responsibility. The city will maintain the tree thereafter. (No plaque will be attached to the tree). At this time the board is working on establishing an area of memorial/commemorative trees along the city portion of the Raccoon River Valley Trail south of Vine Street.
