## Winter Reminders

- Streets During snow events when plowing will be necessary, please remove all vehicles from City streets, alleys or City owned off-street parking areas. Vehicles parked in the street may be fined, towed, or both. The parking ban will continue from the beginning of a snowfall to 24 hours after the snowfall has ceased.
- Sidewalks- you have 24 hours after the snowfall to clear your sidewalk or the City may do so and bill the property owner.
- Fire Hydrants it is property owners' responsibility to clear the snow away from hydrants. Thank you!
