RESOLUTION NO. 2019-27

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY'S PRE-APPLICATION FOR A 2019 IOWA GREAT PLACES PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE PAVILION AT THE RACCOON RIVER VALLEY TRAILHEAD

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas Center is submitting a pre-application for an Iowa Great Places Program Grant (in connection with the re-designation by the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs of the Raccoon River Valley Trail as an Iowa Great Place) for the construction of a multiuse pavilion in Heritage Park at the Raccoon River Valley Trailhead, directly adjacent to the "In the Shadow of the Rails" public art and restroom; and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Park Pavilion will be available for local and regional art, music, and cycling events; and will be used by the Roy R. Estle Library staff for children and adult learning programs, the Dallas Center Farmers' Market, local churches, the Dallas Center-Grimes Community School District, Spurgeon, and other community groups and organizations; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes the construction of a celestial style pavilion which will recall a train depot loading platform, which will be complementary to both the "In the Shadow of the Rails" public art and restroom facilities, all to further develop a cohesiveness throughout the Raccoon River Valley Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the grant application and has committed up to \$75,000 in City matching funds if the grant is awarded, such matching funds to be paid equally from the Burnett Trust fund and the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Dallas Center, Iowa, that the City affirms its support for the pre-application for the Iowa Great Places Program Grant toward construction of the Trailhead Pavilion in Heritage Park, and the City commits up to \$75,000 in City matching funds, if the grant is awarded to the City.
