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Mayor Kidd opened a public hearing at 7:00 pm on March12, 2019 as advertised for the purpose of hearing comments on the authorization of a Loan and Disbursement Agreement and the Issuance of Notes to evidence the obligation of the City thereunder (Not to Exceed \$3,025,000 Sewer Revenue Capital Loan Notes) with the following statement: In 2001 we were issued our NPDES permit by the DNR to operate our wastewater treatment plant, that permit expired in 2006. We had been made aware that when the new permit was issued, we would be mandated to meet stricter guidelines, requiring us to upgrade our facility. The new requirements would impose limits on ammonia nitrogen in the effluent and limits on e-coli bacteria in the effluent. The existing lagoon system, while capable of meeting permit requirements at the time of construction and in 2001, would not be able to meet these two new requirements. In 2013 the council increased the sewer rate in order to start saving money for the upgrades that would be mandatory when we received our new permit from the State of Iowa and the city began researching options. In 2016 we received our new permit requirements and began discussing what design options were available to us. In June 2018 council decided to pursue a SAGR system and work began on the design of the system. The estimated cost of the project is 3.1M. The city has approximately \$500,000 saved to use toward this project, allowing us to bond for less than actual cost of the project. We will be utilizing the State Revolving Fund with a 3% interest rate. The Mayor asked for oral comments-Julie Becker had questions. She was made aware all funds are restricted to be used only for this project. This amount is a not to exceed, we use funds necessary for the project. The city did not receive any written comments. Mayor Kidd declared the hearing closed at 7:10 pm.

Mayor Kidd opened a public hearing at 7:10 pm on March 12, 2019 as advertised for the purpose of hearing comments on proposed Fiscal Year 2019-2020 City of Dallas Center Budget. He gave some of the budget highlights. At 7:14 pm he asked for written comments, there were none. The Mayor asked for oral comments-Bob Haxton gave his comments and concerns regarding the budget. Julie Becker gave her comments and concerns regarding the budget. Kluss arrived at 7:21 pm. Bob King gave his comments regarding the budget. Mayor Kidd declared the hearing closed at 7:30 pm.

The Dallas Center City Council met in regular session March 12, 2019 at 7:30 pm. Mayor Kidd called the meeting to order and led the pledge of allegiance. Council members present included David Bagby, Ryan Coon, Danny Beyer and Ryan Kluss. Curtis Pion was not present.

Motion by Beyer, 2nd by Coon to approve agenda. Motion passed 4-0.

Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Bagby to approve consent agenda [approve minutes of February 12th regular meeting and February 18th special meeting; February Treasurer's Report, Cash Report, Function Report; February Law Enforcement, Fire/Rescue, Compliance and Water Reports; approve Mayor's appointment of Susan Collins to fill vacancy on the Parks and Recreation Board, term expires December 31, 2019; approve hiring Mike Buckalew as a public works assistant at \$11.75/hr approximately 20-25 hours per week effective April 1st, pending background check; approve hiring Gary Reutter and James McNeill as summer public works assistants at \$11.00/hr approximately 15 hours/week effective April 1st pending background checks; approve invoices for payment (review committee Bagby and Beyer)]. Motion passed 4-0.

Public Communications and Concerns-

Bob Haxon stated his concerns regarding conflict of interest.

Julie Becker-stated her concerns on city motto, conflict of interest, gave comments on park board item.

Bob King-informed council of an AARP Community Challenge Grant

City Attorney Ralph Brown made a statement responding to the accusation of conflict of interest. He made it clear per lowa Code Section 362.5 there is absolutely no conflict of interest in regard to the library addition.

Council member Beyer gave the following remarks regarding accusations by citizens: he presented facts

regarding tax abatements and the differences between our and Adel's; he explained that valuations are increasing due to more houses and more growth; he stated that we are not deficit spending but spending money that has been saved rather than getting a loan for large purchases such has the plow truck, he reiterated that there is no conflict of interest regarding the library project; he explained that formal pay rates for the employees are set in June and that we are on a high deductible health insurance plan to try and keep costs down. He also explained that we don't know what insurance rates will be a year out so we budget accordingly; he stated personal attacks on the city clerk by certain citizens needs to stop and clarified that the clerk's wages as published for calendar 2018 were \$60,528; he compared the clerk's wages to school and other city's wages; he stated that many cities have a city administrator, a clerk, and a finance officer and that our clerk does the work of all those positions; lastly, he explained that it doesn't make sense to budget according to the inflation rate when the growth within our city is more than the inflation rate.

Mary Werch, Park and Recreation Board – discussed designating the trailhead and former lumberyard area as a city park. Attorney Brown stated the council would need to pass a resolution and name the park. Council directed Attorney Brown to draft a resolution for next month.

Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Beyer to receive the Auditor of State's Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures for the period July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018. Motion passed 4-0.

Slaughter gave the public works report-thanked council for all of their work; 8 snow events and hauled the snow; cleaned intakes; received and used the last load of salt; made plow repairs-axle shaft, hydraulic tank; repaired snow blower; pothole filling has started; water main break repair; DNR license renewals and CPO license update completed.

Water Treatment Plant Backwash Improvements Project –Engineer Veenstra made council aware that the DNR will grant the city's permit for work to be completed on the south side. Work should start in the next week or two.

Not to Exceed \$3,025,00 Sewer Revenue Capital Loan Notes (SRF)

Veenstra explained the process for the project and discussed the precursor actions, getting loan closed, bids will be received this summer, he stated there are new contractors in the market and they've been seeing prices coming in lower causing a favorable market.

Motion by Kluss, 2nd by Beyer to approve Resolution 2019-7 – instituting proceedings to take additional action for the authorization of a Loan and Disbursement Agreement and the Issuance of Not to Exceed \$3,025,000 Sewer Revenue Capital Loan Notes. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

Motion by Coon, 2nd by Kluss to approve Resolution 2019-8 – approving Fiscal Year 2019-2020 City of Dallas Center budget. Roll call all ayes, motion passed.

Fire Chief Hofland presented information on the purchase of an I-Pad. Motion by Coon, 2nd by Bagby to approve fire department's purchase of an I-Pad and monthly data service. I-Pad cost not to exceed \$1300 and \$600 annually for data service. Motion passed 4-0.

Veenstra gave history on the annexation moratoriums with Waukee and Adel. They will be expiring soon. He explained that moratoriums have a ten-year cap. Adel agreement expires this year and Waukee expires 2021. The Mayor will reach out to Adel and Waukee to discuss possible moratorium extensions. The clerk will schedule an annexation workshop with councilmen Kluss and Beyer in the near future.

Council reports-Coon-thanked employees for their work on the website Beyer would like the relocation of the Veteran's Memorial placed on the April agenda

Mayor's report-Kidd stated he thought the new website looked good.

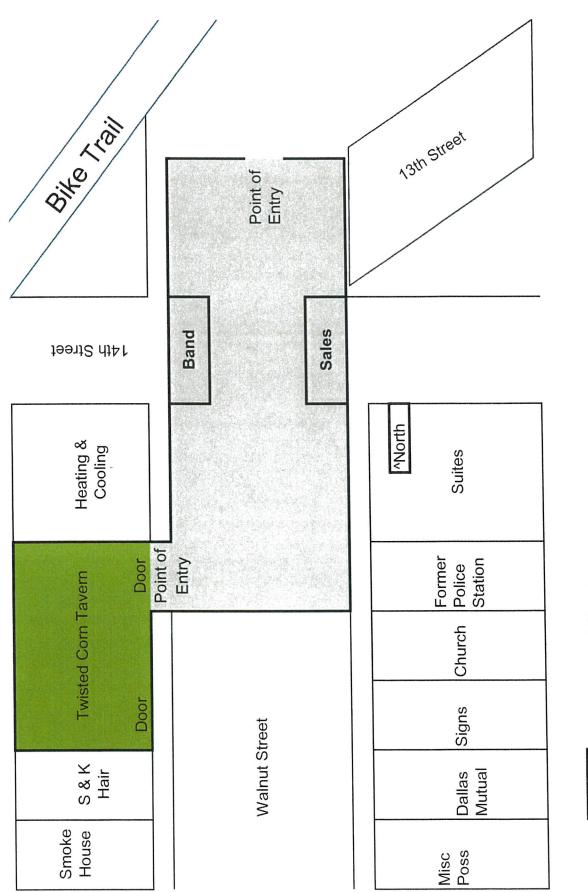

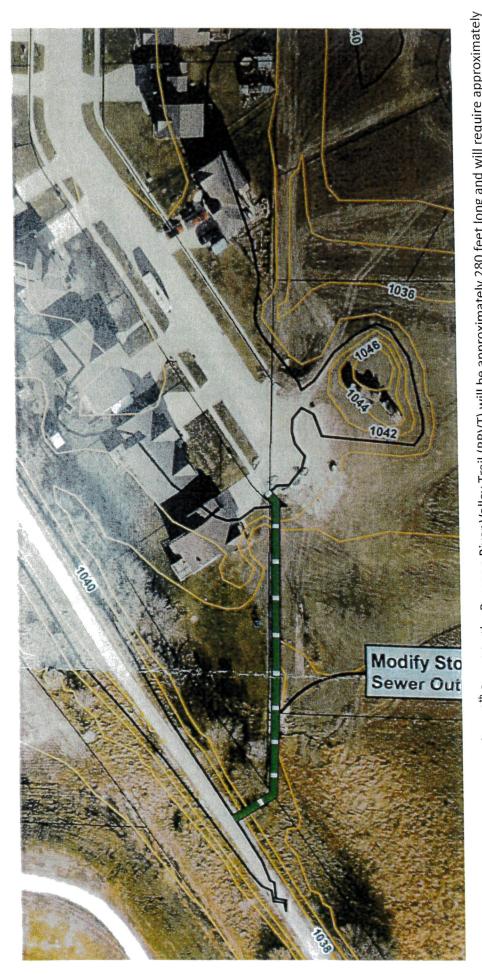

The above proposed trail connector from 8th Street to the Raccoon River Valley Trail (RRVT) will be approximately 280 feet long and will require approximately 160 square yards of PCC pavement to make a path 5 feet wide. Significant grading and surface restoration will be required to create a trail that is level enough from 8th Street to the RRVT to meet ADA standards. Since this path will be located over the top of the existing storm sewer, it will also be necessary to modify the existing storm sewer outlet by turning and angling it to the southeast. The flared end section and rip rap will need to be relocated.

The note below is from Larry Berland, the contact for the Iowa Tennis Coaches Association

Bob,

Sorry for the delay but I have finally finished shoveling snow and ice off our tennis courts! That means that we can begin to practice outdoors.

In answer to your question about what backboard to purchase the following suggestions were given.

If you construct your own from plywood or similar materials, the life span is not great. They begin to lose color very quickly and the wood begins to deteriorate in just a few years.

The backboards recommended were constructed of a hard plastic with the color infused into the material so they do not lose their color. They also are very durable with reports of still looking and functioning well after 15 years plus of use. The types recommended were from Bakko, Rally Master, and Court Master.

Picking a size has to do with your court set-up and expected use. Normal dimensions were 10 foot high by 16 feet wide. If you can afford the added cost, however, 24 feet provides hitting surface for 2 to 3 people at a time. You can purchase curved plastic boards that return the ball as typical of rallying on a court but they do extend an added 30 inches onto the court.

In Decorah, we have a 10x16 foot Rally Master plastic board that they purchased and installed 9 years ago and it still looks and functions like new. It is not a bottom curved model but does have a bit of a curve at the top which stops balls from going out over the top as easily. I like hitting on it but do wish it were a bit wider so that two players could use it at the same time during practice.

I hope this helps with your decision.
