ONLINE PAYMENTS

- The City of Dallas Center is excited to announce that we will be accepting online payments for utility services through GovPayNet beginning the month of April (exact date TBD).
- To make a payment visit the city's website at www.dallascenter.com and click on the "Online Payments" tab located on the home page.
- Once on the GovPayNet payment screen you will need to know your utility account number to access your account information and a processing fee of 2.65% with a minimum of \$1.00 will be added to your payment.
- GovPayNet accepts major credit and debit card brands and the site will be available 24/7.

FREE SESQUICENTENNIAL TREES

- Show your Dallas Center spirit by planting an Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry seedling in honor of our town's 150th anniversary. They grow to 15-20 feet tall, with white flowers in Spring and orange/red leaves in Fall. They are also a great plant for butterflies and other pollinators. Quantities are limited.
- In partnership with the Brenton Arboretum, we will also be celebrating Arbor Day by offering several additional varieties of free seedlings that have been made available through the Iowa Department of Natural Resources Trees for Communities program for counties impacted by the emerald ash borer.
- It's first come, first served for any of the trees at the Gazebo in Mound Park on April 27th. Bring your own 5-gallon bucket and take home some free mulch with your new tree.
- We will kick things off with a brief Arbor Day ceremony at 9:00 am and a tree planting demonstration. Tree give away 9:00 am to noon.

Yard waste pick-up will resume on April 1st. Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, twigs, etc.) can be placed on the curb for pick-up every Monday through November. To insure pick-up, yard waste should be:

- Out on your curb by 7:00 am (this is the same as garbage and recycling)
- Placed in brown paper bags, paper grocery bags, cardboard boxes or trash cans (not Waste Management container)
- Bundled brush tied securely with twine or string; weighing less than 50 lbs & no longer than 4' in length
