Mosquito Spraying – This summer City certified pesticide applicators will spray an ultra- low volume non thermal aerosol (cold fog) to control adult mosquitoes in residential and recreational areas and other non-cropland areas where these insects are a problem. The City will use BIOMIST 1.5+7.5 ULV. Best results are achieved when the temperatures are cooler and the wind speed is below 10 mph (we typically try to spray on Wednesday or Thursdsay nights. No special precautions are necessary for residents normally, but you may call City Hall at 992-3725 for more information.
