Yard waste reminders: Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves, twigs, etc.) can be placed on the curb for pick-up every Monday through November. To insure pick-up, yard waste should be:

- Out on your curb by 7:00 am (this is the same as garbage and recycling)
- Placed in brown paper bags, paper grocery bags, cardboard boxes or trash cans (not Waste Management container)
- Bundled brush tied securely with twine or string; weighing less than 50 lbs & no longer than 4' in length

The next open burning period is October 1 – November 30. Please do not burn any yard waste at this time. Thank you.

Do you know where the water shut off valve is inside your house? If you don't, you should find it. Then, "exercise" the valve (turn it off and on). If it does not work, call your friendly neighborhood plumber and get it fixed. At some time, you may be glad you did.

#### Do you know who CIRHA is?

- Central Iowa Regional Housing Authority (CIRHA) is a Housing Authority that helps low income families with rental assistance in Boone, Dallas, Jasper, Madison, Marion and Story counties.
- Families pay 30% of their gross adjusted income for the rent and the Housing Authority pays the difference directly to the landlord on the first of each month.
