- Wastewater Treatment facility improvements are mostly complete.
- We will be replacing three filters and the media in the softeners at the water treatment plant. This project will begin in the fall.
- Council accepted the revised Master Plan submitted by ISG for the Downtown Streetscape and Green Corridor, Phase 1-site survey and street trees in the 1400 block of Walnut will begin this summer.
- The Library remodel is complete and a ribbon cutting ceremony was held.
- Multiple street resurfacing projects (portions of Hatton, Sycamore, 15th and 9th) are scheduled for this summer.

Code Enforcement Reminders

With summer quickly approaching, I wanted to give you some reminders to help keep Dallas Center a place we can all be proud of:

- Please pick up after your pets!
- Grass, weeds or brush shall be cut, mowed and maintained so as not to exceed the following height specifications:
 - 1. Developed Residential Areas not to exceed eight inches (8").
 - 2. Undeveloped Residential Areas not to exceed ten inches (10").
 - 3. Business and Industrial Areas not to exceed eight inches (8").

Grass, weeds and brush which are allowed to grow in excess of the above specified limitations are deemed to be nuisances and to be violations of this chapter.

- Tall grass, weeds, and brush/limb piles are not only unsightly they give cover for those bothersome and disease carrying mosquitoes.
- Anything that will hold water is an invitation for a mosquito. It only takes a hand full of water for a mosquito to lay eggs, so please don't leave open containers in the yard.
- Let's continue to make Dallas Center a beautiful, safe and healthy place to live and raise a family.
