Street tree maintenance ~ The City has contracted with Dallas County Orchard LLC to remove tree branches or trees in the right-of-way that have been found by the Dallas Center Tree Board to be damaged or diseased. "Council Corner"

- Council approved Resolution 2021-10 –to establish the Dallas Center Swimming Pool Planning & Advisory Committee.
- Council approved Ordinance No. 550- amending Section 92.05 of the Code of Ordinances by changing the water reconnection fee to a delinquent customer to a \$50. flat fee charge.
- Council approved Ordinance No. 552- increasing the fees for the residential solid waste removal to a rate of \$20.00 (last increased to \$19.50 in March of 2013) and increasing the commercial solid waste removal rate to a minimum of \$23.03 each month, all effective March 16, 2021.
