To make a utility payment (no building permits, pet licenses, etc.), go to our website at: https://www.dallascenter.com/ and click on Online Payments on the left side of the Home screen. You must have your account number to pay online (this can be found on your monthly bill).
- ★ This feature is in addition to the automatic payment (ACH) that we offer. So, if you are already signed up for automatic pay nothing will change.
- ★ Payments must be made before 11:00 pm on the 15th to avoid a penalty.
